DIRECTIONS FOR USE:



STEP 1

Choose area to be masked and tear off a small section to mask a tight corner or a section no longer than 20cm for a straight section. Tear the tape down to the plastic section, then slide between the rubber trim and bodywork. Ensure all pieces overlap.



STEP 2

Apply pressure to secure.



STEP 3

Allow paint to dry and remove all masking materials.



STEP 4

Check edges and polish if necessary.
