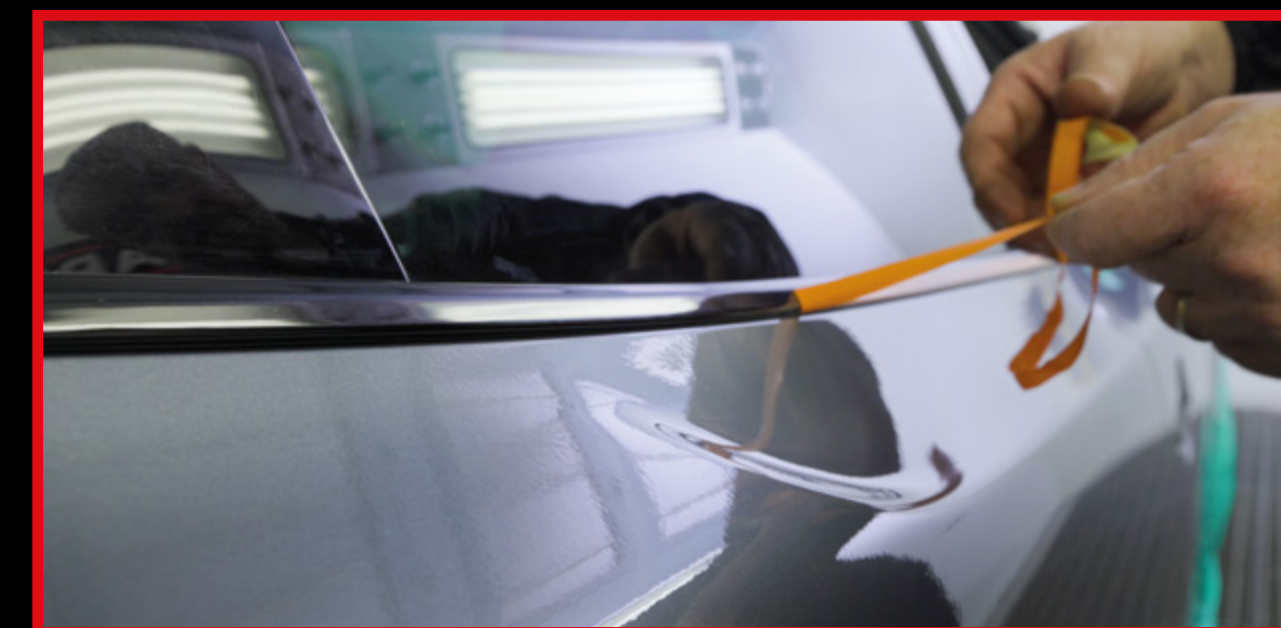
STEP 1
